Canvassing the 2020 Municipal Election Results


WHEREAS, the general election for the Town of Harpersville was duly and legally held on Tuesday, August 25, 2020, as provided by law; and

1. That Beverly Oden Johnson received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember – District 1, Place 1 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2020.
2. That Janet Gill received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember – District 2, Place 3 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November 2020.
