Police Department:

Police Chief Jimmy Macon reported a citizen was struck and killed by a vehicle on the night of November 17, 2019. He stated the driver of the vehicle was not at fault. He said he has received numerous requests for street lights to be installed on this section of road. He noted thefts are still being reported around town and speed is continuing to be an issue along U.S. Highway 280. He reported a sex offender, recently released from jail, did not register upon his release and was taken back into custody with the assistance of the Shelby County Sherriff's Office.

Library:

Librarian Marsha Moore reported giving away a large number of books at Harpersville Day on Saturday, November 9th. Mayor Greene noted the importance of citizens utilizing the library for Census 2020.
