1. Hiring of NON APOST officers

Councilmember Carter made a motion to change the hiring policy to allow for the hiring of NON APSOST certified officers, upon successful completion of the Pre Cert Physical Agility Test. Councilmember Gill seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously

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by voice vote of those members of the Council present, and Mayor Perkins declared the same passed.

NEW BUSINESS / RESOLUTIONS / ORDINANCES / ORDERS and OTHER BUSINESS –

1. Pallet Fork Purchase Approval

Councilmember Gill made a motion to approve the purchase of a pallet fork with the Water Board paying for half of the cost. Councilmember Rich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote of those members present, and Mayor Perkins declared the same passed.

2. Hiring of NON APOST candidates, Jamie Kelley and Ryan Kelow

Councilmember Dates made a motion to approve the hiring of Jamie Kelley and Ryan Kelow. Councilmember Rich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote of those members present, and Mayor Perkins declared the same passed.

3. Appointment of Police Chief

Councilmember Gill made a motion to disapprove the reappointment of Chief Jimmy Macon. Councilmember Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed by roll call voice vote of those present:

Mayor Perkins-Yes Councilmember Janet Gill-Yes Councilmember William Carter-Yes Councilmember Martin Dates-Abstained Councilmember Sheila Rich- Yes Councilmember Beverly Johnson-Yes

Mayor Perkins stated that he had spoken with retired Officer Lee Carden to serve as interim Chief, in the event that Chief Macon was not reappointed. Officer Lee Carden has nearly 30 years of law enforcement experience. Councilmember Gill made a motion to approve the appointment of Officer Lee Carden as interim Chief. Councilmember Rich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote of those members present, and Mayor Perkins declared the same passed. Councilmember Gill inquired on when the job posting for Chief of Police would be posted. Mayor Perkins advised that the position would be posted by the end of the week.
