1. Paving

Councilmember Rich made a motion to accept the contract from Dalvin Transportation, LLC for Phase I-M Meadows Golf Course in the amount of \$28, 920.00. Councilmember Dates seconded the motion. The motion passed by voice vote. Mayor Perkins declared motion passed.

2. Special work session with Chief of Police held February 27, 2023 follow up

The Town Council requested prices for 3 to 4 vehicles to replace some in the current fleet. Chief Smith will present numbers at the next regular scheduled council meeting along with a list of current vehicles that can be labeled as surplus property. Mayor Perkins addressed Police salaries and stated those figures need to be included in the budget meeting in early June 2023.

In addition, Councilmember Rich motioned to order four trash bins for the event. Councilmember Dates seconded the motion. The motion passed by voice vote. Mayor Perkins declared motion passed.
